



Travel Information for Marriages

Currently only the couple marrying would be permitted to enter Gibraltar. Family and friends unfortunately are not permitted to enter Gibraltar. You should check if you also require a visa to enter Gibraltar.

Travel to Gibraltar via the UK

A letter is required from Borders and Coastguards Agency in Gibraltar to travel to Gibraltar. This letter is to be requested from marriages.csro@gibraltar.gov.gi. The Marriage Section will forward your details to the Borders and Coastguards Agency. The letter will be emailed to you by Borders and Coastguards Agency.

You will need to present this letter at the airport in the United Kingdom at the checking-in desks and on arrival at Gibraltar passport control. A copy on a mobile phone would be sufficient.

All passengers arriving from the UK will require a Covid test. This can be either:

1. A test carried out in the UK, up to 72 hours prior to the time of your departure flight. (proof will be required)
2. A test carried out in Gibraltar within 24 hours of your arrival. Fees are £50, payable to the testing service company, pre-booking is recommended. Further information on www.covidrapidtest.gi

Travel to Gibraltar via Spain

The neighbouring towns to Gibraltar are in a perimeter lockdown, entry to these towns may not be permitted. You should make enquiries with the Spanish authorities if your travel through these towns to travel to Gibraltar is within their permitted exemptions.

Currently there are restrictions on persons to be able to return to Spain.

- Only the following may re-enter Spain:
 1. Persons who hold full Spanish Residence (Residence in any other EU state is not acceptable)
 2. Spanish Nationals.
- If you are unable to return to Spain, you would require to produce the following at the frontier:
 1. Proof of a flight from Gibraltar to the United Kingdom
 2. Hotel accommodation

We would not be able to permit you entry into Gibraltar, if you cannot meet the above requirements.

There is no requirement to produce a PCR test when entering via the frontier, please see "Countries which require self-isolation".

A person who marries a Spanish national or a person who holds residence in Spain, is not able to enter Spain on the grounds of the marriage, this person would need to hold residence in Spain themselves.



Currently we have two flights to the United Kingdom:

- Easyjet – EZY8901 on Fridays
- British Airways – BA493 on Saturdays

Should your flight be diverted to Malaga, you would not be able to travel to Malaga and will have to remain in Gibraltar until the next available flight.

Travel to the United Kingdom

You may not travel to the United Kingdom if you have been in some countries in the last ten days. This would not apply if you are a resident in the United Kingdom or are a British or Irish national. Please also see below for persons who may have visited certain countries.

You would require a covid test to travel to the United Kingdom.

Countries which require self-isolation

Should you have been in the last 14 days in a country other than the following, you would need to self-isolate in Gibraltar for 5 days.

During your isolation, you must not leave your hotel room and not use any of the public areas.

You must have a test on arrival at Gibraltar and on the fifth day.

Should your stay be less than 5 days, the second test can be taken between the 3rd day and the 5th day.

Restrictions in your country of residence

It is your responsibility to ensure that your travel to Gibraltar for the purpose of marriage is not contrary to any measures that may be in place in your country of residence. You would need to contact your local authorities for advice.



Restrictions on entry to persons having visited certain countries

If you have visited or transited the following countries in the last ten days, entry into Gibraltar regardless of point of entry will not be granted:

Current restrictions in Gibraltar

1. Face masks must be worn in all public areas
2. You must not leave your hotel room between the hours of 2200hrs to 0600hrs.

Note: if you are required to be in self-isolation you may not leave your hotel room.
